How Did Rotary Start?

The first Rotary club was organized in Chicago, Illinois by **Paul Harris**, an attorney. The first meeting was held on February 23, 1905. The name **Rotary** was chosen because the club met in **rotation** at each member's work place.

The Rotary idea of **friendship**, **fellowship**, and **service** to others quickly spread to six continents.
